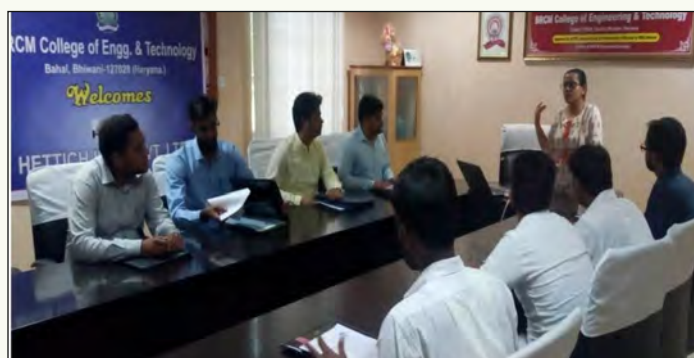

Workshop on Career Counseling by 'Extra Marks'



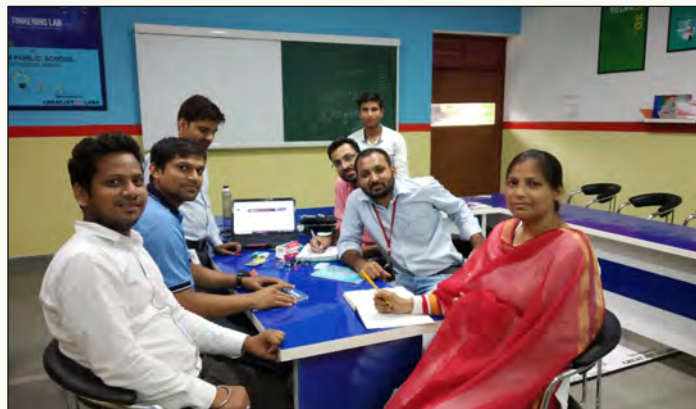

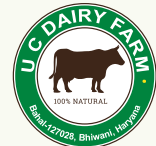
