# बहल यात्रा की यादगार लम्हे...

5 से 9 जनवरी, 2020 का बहल प्रवास मेरे लिए 'याद गाँव' के सफर की मानिंद था। हर पल, हर कदम सुदूर बचपन की यादों के गलियारे से होकर गुजरता हुआ उन्हें जीवंत कर रहा था।

गाड़ी के झुंपा से बहल की ओर मुड़ने के साथ ही स्मृतियों की हिलोरें शुरू हो गयीं। बचपन में हर गर्मी कार में इसी रस्ते से गुजरते थे, सड़क दोनों ओर से रेत से ढक जाती और कभी-कभी तो गाड़ी रोकनी भी पड़ती थी। शादी के बाद हिसार से बहल इसी सड़क से आना होता, झुंपा से मुड़ते ही, बहल और दादीजी-दादाजी के प्यार की गर्माहट का एहसास होने लगता था।

बहल पहुँचते ही सबसे पहले बस अड्डे के दर्शन हुए। ये जगह पहले गाँव का 'New Market' हुआ करती थी। दुकानों के नाम पर जो थीं बस यही थीं। कितना उत्साह रहता था हम बच्चों में अड्डे तक जाने का! आज वहाँ नई पुरानी ढेरों इमारतें, दुकानें, ठेले, गाड़ियाँ और शोर शराबा देखकर अंदेशा हो गया कि गाँव अब गाँव नहीं रहा, कस्बे का रूप ले चुका है। फिर परिचित पुरानी गलियों से गुजरते हुए, दादाजी की दुकान, विमला चाची का घर, पुलिस थाना, पुराना कुआँ, ब्राह्मणों की हवेली आदि को पहचानने की कोशिश करते हम घर आ पहुँचे।

गाड़ी रुकते ही एक ललक के साथ अंदर दौड़ी। एक-एक करके हर कमरा, चौका, पैंडा, स्टोर (वहाँ रखी वही चिर परिचित अलमारी जिसमें से उठा-उठा हम दिन भर लड्डू पेड़े खाते थे), पीछे का दालान, बगीचा, गाय का नोहरा देखा। आंखें देख रहीं थीं हर जगह का आज का स्वरूप और मन विचर रहा था उनकी पुरानी स्मृतियों के बीच। छत पर पहुँची तो वहाँ तारों भरे आकाश के नीचे, खाटों पर बिताई असंख्य रातों के चित्र जीवंत हो उठे - कितनी कहानियाँ, कितने किस्से, कैसी निर्दोष खिलखिलाहट! अनायास ही मन पुकार उठा 'कोई लौटा दे मेरे बीते हुए वे बचपन के दिन'... किसी शायर ने सच ही कहा है "थम के रह जाती है जिंदगी, जब जम के बरसती है पुरानी यादें"। पुरानी नई बातें करते हमने कढ़ी, बाजरे की रोटी-शक्कर वाला शुद्ध देसी खाना खाया और फिर स्मृतियों की बुककल को लपेटे, उसकी गर्माहट को संजोते सोने चले गए।

अगले दिन सुबह-सुबह विमला चाची दौड़ी चली आई मिलने, और प्यार से गले लगाकर ढेरों आशीषों के साथ सर पर हाथ फेरने लगी। उनसे भी तो बहल आना जुड़ा हुआ सा है। दादीजी की friend cum confidante हुआ करती थी विमला चाची और खूब अच्छा खाना बना कर सदा खिलाती रही। बाद के वर्षों में मम्मी आतीं बहल तो हमेशा चाची ने उनका मन लगाये रखा।

फिर मिली दुलारी बुआ, पचास से भी ज्यादा साल हो गए हैं उनको हमारे घर में आते हुए, हम सबको उन्होंने नहलाया है, मालिश की है, कपड़े धोये हैं। दुलारी बुआ हमारे लिए मनोरंजन का फुलटू साधन हुआ करती थी -पूरे गाँव की अंदर तक की खबर उनको होती थी और वो उसे चाट सा चटाकेदार बनाकर हमें सुनाती थी -uncensored! आज 65-70 की उम्र में भी

दुलारी बुआ वही छरहरी सतर काया लिए फर-फर फिरती काम करती है - खेतों में, घर पर और लोगों के यहाँ भी। उनके जैसा संतोषी जीव मैंने आज तक नहीं देखा। कम उम्र में वैधव्य, सीमित साधन, जवान बेटे का कैंसर से गुजरना -किसी भी बात का गिला नहीं उन्हें ईश्वर से, हर परिस्थिति स्वीकार करते हुए उद्यम करते रहने को ही जीवन मंत्र बना रखा है उसने।

अगले दिन नाश्ते के बाद निदेशक डॉ. सिन्हाजी ने पूर्व निर्धारित रुपरेखा के अनुसार एक के बाद एक संस्थाएँ दिखानी शुरू कीं। काफी कुछ देखा हुआ था, बहुत कुछ नया भी। ज्ञानकुंज एवं विद्याग्राम अब एक परिपक्व संस्थान का रूप लेकर अपने systems में स्थापित से लगे। बहल में समग्र शिक्षा-Nursery से लेकर Post Graduate तक का ऐसा वृहद् समायोजन देखकर बहुत अच्छा लगा और ऐसी परिकल्पना करने तथा उसे साकार कर पाने पर एक पारिवारिक गर्व की अनुभूति भी हुई। BRCM Skill Development Center देख कर तो बहुत ही अच्छा लगा - महिलाओं को रोजगार मुहैया कराने वाला यह संस्थान उनके सशक्तिकरण की तरफ एक ठोस कदम की तरह है।

### Plant Trees

Trees help clean the air we breathe, filter the water we drink and provide habitat to over 80% of the world's biodiversity. Forest provides jobs to over 1.6 billion people, absorb harmful carbon from the atmosphere and are key ingredients in one quarter of all medicines. Trees are like the vacuums of our planet. Through their leaves and barks, they suck up harmful pollutants and release clean oxygen for us to breathe. Planting trees is anyway your contribution to planet in biggest manner.



### Save Energy

At home, simple actions such as turning off the lights and unplugging computers or turning off televisions can help us reduce our consumption and thereby conserve energy. Installing thermostat technology is another means of saving energy and identifying the gadgets and appliances that are drawing power from the outlets even when not in use (more casually known as energy vampire). At the commercial level, updating older buildings with new & installing more efficient technology can help reduce the amounts of electricity required to power a business.



### Reduce Your Waste

Reducing the amount of waste you bring in and the amount of trash that goes to the landfill is an important part of any green lifestyle. Also there's a lot more to it than just recycling plastic or throwing your trash in a bin. ### Reduce, Reuse and Recycle

When you do buy stuff, try to make sure it's stuff that will last a long time and can serve multiple purposes; avoid buying non disposable items when possible. Also, consider the "greenness" of the company that made it! Before throwing anything away, try to find creative ways to reuse it. You'd be surprised what you can do with old Altoids tins, socks, plastic bags, plastic bottles and well, everything.



### Save Water

An estimated 50% of all household water usage is wasted. It goes down the drain while we wait for it to warm up or evaporates more quickly than it needs to. In an era when our fresh water supply is diminishing due to pollution and drought, it's important to conserve all the water we can, as well as learn about and put to use grey water recycling practices.
