Remembering Mahendra Kumar Chaudhary “A Journey Too Short”

Fondly known as MKC, he left all of us too soon before even we were ready to say proper good-bye. We realise he is not physically with us but will try to live through the memories with him, that are too beautiful to forget and to be cherished forever. His sudden demise has unsettled all of us. We had a special fondness for him since childhood. His enthusiastic caress on the face will now become just a fleeting feeling. As life is short but the soul remains immortal, he will always remain in our hearts.

Everyone judged his working style and behaviour differently, but his unspoken dedication for the welfare of entire family, friends and associates was tremendous. A man of few words but with boldness and fearlessness beyond compare, had fantastic industrial and business skills and acumen. He had in depth knowledge and grip on many historical, literary, philosophical subjects along with esoteric consciousness of many contemporary national and international issues. His decisive efficiency and goodness of heart, became a strong cornerstone of the advancement of our family values. His lifestyle of real simplicity and enormous faith in abilities of his subordinates will always act as a guiding

beacon for next generation of entire Chaudhary family.

MKC, born at Bahal, Haryana, to an illustrious icon Late Chhogmal ji & Late Kalavati Devi ji Chaudhary is survived by his daughters Vipula, Vasudha, Vidhushree and Son Vedant. He lost his sincere and dedicated life partner Manisha ji about a decade back due to illness. He had four Sisters namely Premlata, Kanta, Saroj and Vijaylaxmi and was third in seniority among four brothers namely Hari Krishna, Shiv Kumar and Pramod. He completed his schooling at Govt. Sr. Secondary School, Bahal and went on to become the first Mechanical Engineer in the entire Chaudhary family from Thapar University, Patiala, Punjab.

During 62 years of his short life span he established a number of business ventures. He played a key role in laying the foundation of “PRATIBHA GROUP” in Surat, Gujarat. Starting with a small setup of a Textile Processing Unit (Pratibha Mill) during the year 1981 – 82, he went on to establish a number of business entities in varied domains like, Dyes & Chemicals (Spectrum Dyes & Chemicals), Technical Coating on Fabrics (Nobletex Industries), Nylon Spinning & Polymer

Engineering(Gujarat Polyfilms), Weaving of Linen Fabrics (Kottex Industries), Denim Manufacturing (Anubha Industries) & Trading of High Value Added Fabrics (Pratibha Fashion).

His business efforts made the group a good contributor to the State Exchequer and growth of Textile Industry in Gujarat, providing & creating manifold employment opportunities. As a pioneer entrepreneur in the field of textile processing, he was always very concerned and enthusiastic about use of technology and newer developments in Industries and curiously engaged himself in the finding out possibilities for their concurrent technical up-gradation. 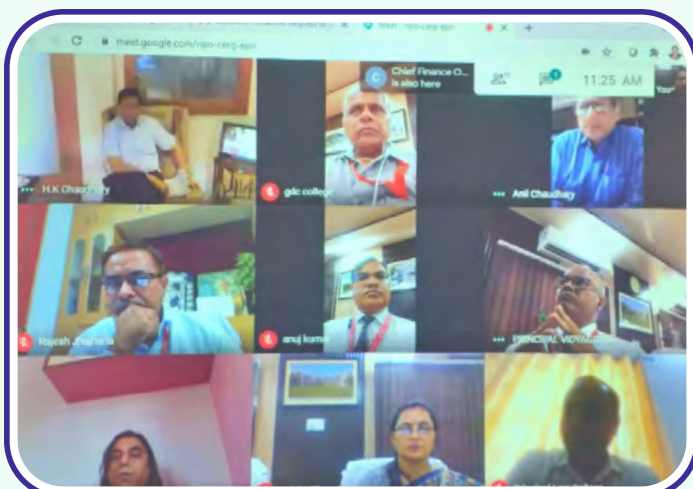

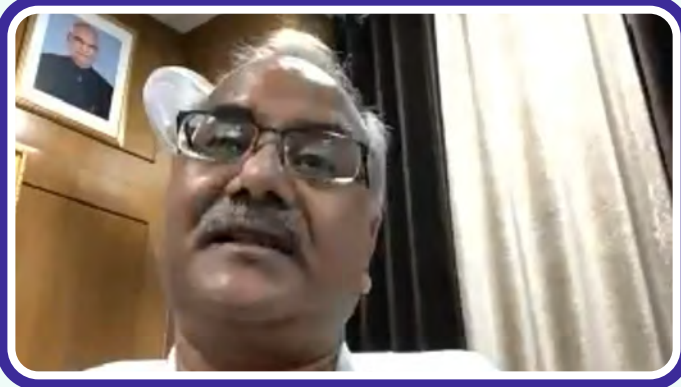


National Live Webinar Organised by BRCM Education Society on “National Education Policy - 2020”

Impact of Accreditation and Quality Assurance in Higher Education

Finding the appropriate higher education institution is now a challenge for most parents, students and even faculty. Competition is everywhere and it has even hit academia. Well-established institutions always care about the quality they are providing in addition to their image whether locally or internationally. The numbers of higher education institutions is increasing and to stay in the lead universities need to look for a competitive edge. Universities are now competing with their history, location, employability, reputation and quality of learning. Higher education institutions are now looking at satisfying the standard by standard list assigned by internationally or nationally recognized accreditation agencies.

The purpose of accreditation is to investigate whether outside quality confirmation can truly influence the inward life of higher education institutions. Will accreditation implementation have an impact on teaching and learning enhancement and drive institution change? Quality of learning and education is an ever-sought emblem that most educational institutions seek to acquire throughout their years of

operations. The objective of the accreditation organizations is to enhance the quality of education. Thus, effects should be expected in terms of higher quality and effectiveness.

Recently, the increase in high expectations has given rise to additional demands for more accurate assessment of educational institutions in terms of processes, organizational infrastructure and achievements. The role of educational institutions as own arbitrators of quality has been eroded due to deteriorating confidence of society in ability and Prowers of these institutions to effectively assess and validate achievements and standards of educational institutions. Current Business Schools are competing in a complex and competitive market. International accreditations have become key means and reputable Business Schools use them to pursue legitimacy and global status.

Accreditation Principles

The ultimate goal of accrediting agencies is to improve the education level offered by institutions of higher education. An increasingly viable question is how to deduce whether the educational institution has

effectively graduated qualified students that are deemed as effectively capable of entering into the job market and pursuing a particular profession.

Evaluation criteria it comes as no surprise to see terminologies of quality and distinction commonly used in mission statements of educational institutions. Yet, it is also not surprising at all to find that said distinction and quality are abstract measures that can rarely be scientifically defined and that the criteria for gauging their levels of existence tend to be latent or obscured. Measuring an organization's quality of achievements and level of effectiveness is diverse and complex task to do considering the imminent variability of outcomes and absence of

Quality learning, Quality teaching identifies and students past experiences and acquired knowledge. The diversity exhibited by students is effectively exploited to extract pedagogical outcomes and resources. Good teaching leads to a good learning outcome. Some researchers proclaim that teaching should be student centered; while others stress on the methodologies used in teaching.

Indian Higher Education

In recent debates on higher education, general accreditation of all institutions in formal University system has received considerable attention. To meet the international challenge, the Indian higher educational institutions attempt to differentiate themselves on the basis of quality and which is where accreditation comes to play. More and more institutions in India are coming forward to get accredited to attain global standards.

Indian Experience of Accreditation Though Indian economy is on the road map of reforms ever since 1990, educational reforms are on a slow pace. Recently, the Government of India has initiated a number of educational reforms in 2010 to meet the global challenges. The Ministry of Human Resource Development has placed a number of proposals for Parliamentary approval and the outcome is awaited. Presently, the responsibility of accrediting formal University system in India in the public domain is vested in the hands of a Government appointed autonomous body called as **National Assessment and Accreditation Council** (NAAC) and technical education sector assessment comes under the purview of the **National Board of Accreditation**

(NBA). While NAAC accredits all categories of higher education institutions other than agricultural Universities, NBA's domain activities are constrained only to programme accreditation of Technical Institutions. The benchmarks of quality shall be determined by the statutory authorities of the **University Grants Commission** (UGC and the **All India Council of Technical Education** (AICTE) respectively, In addition, **Indian Council of Agricultural Research** (ICAR) accredits the programmes as well as Institutions of Agricultural Education.

Autonomy given to Quality assessment agency is critical to the effectiveness of its operations and allows becoming a role model of quality. India is yet to streamline Accreditation of cross border education.

Accreditation stimulates the academic environment for promotion of quality. It calls for initiatives by the state to make the connection between higher education and the quality more efficient as a means for sectoral growth. This can be achieved by having a proper mix of intervention at the systemic level by the state by making accreditation mandatory within specific time frame and the commitment of higher educational institutions towards quality on the other. While the nature and quality of regulation for the private institutions is to be streamlined more investment in public institutions with an increased accountability mechanism is needed. Considering the limitation of resources for public funding, strategic deployment of funds linked to accreditation can leverage quality advancement in Universities/ Institutions.

On the part of the institutions, special initiatives are required to enhance quality. NAAC/ NBA accreditation mechanism portrays the roadmap in this direction. Curriculum and content has to be continually renewed through Teaching and Learning Support Networks and specific skill development network may be set up. Considerable pool of quality manpower corollary to the higher education system has enabled India to achieve enviable success in global knowledge economy. Educational reform measures towards quality assurance has already been initiated by the UGC/ AICTE and the Government of India and any further sustainable improvement will be led only by implementation of reforms.

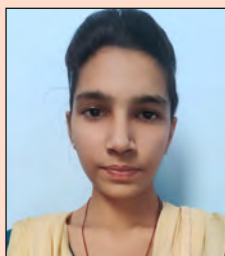
Participation in Social Entrepreneurship Swachhta (SES REC) and Recognition by Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India

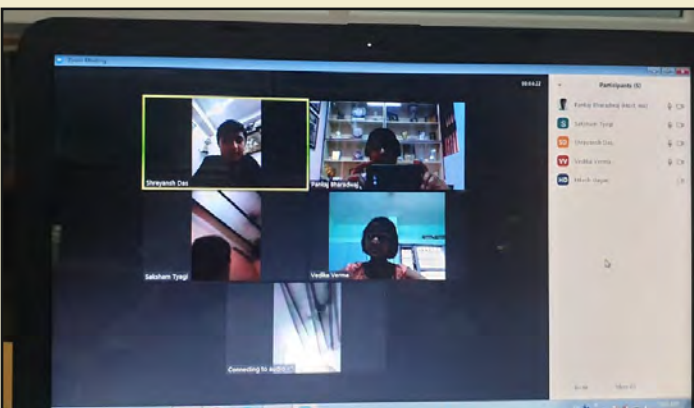
Fit India Freedom Run on National Sports Day
