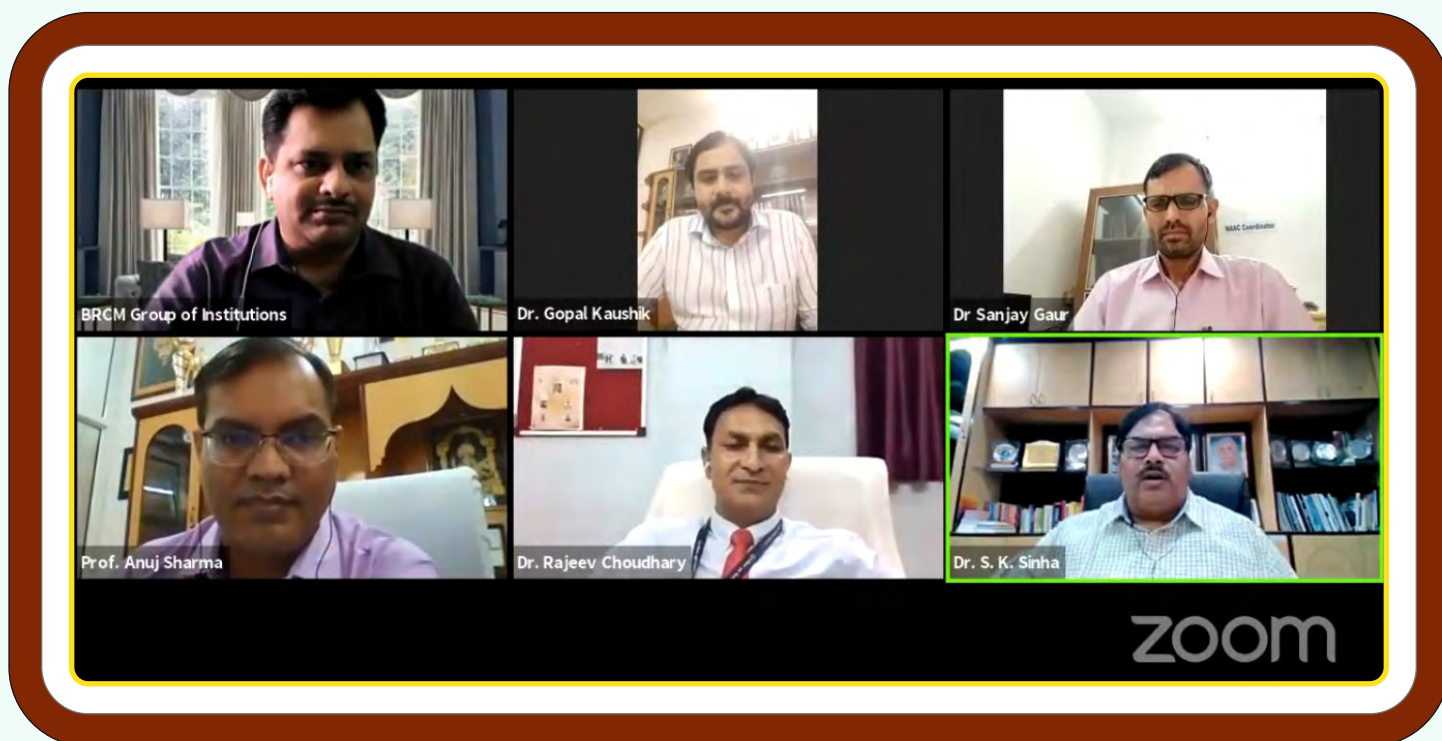
Dr. Harish Chaudhry, Associate Professor, IIT- Delhi and an eminent educationist & Faculty Trainer delivered an expert talk on the above subject and enlighten the audience with his in-depth knowledge in this area. Dr Harish quoted that “**A Teacher is A Teacher**” whether it is online or offline teaching. The teacher must learn to work on all teaching tools so that they can help the students for better results. He emphasized that teaching is a noble profession and every teacher have to perform their duties; understand their responsibilities and try to give their best to the students and every teacher have to learn 21st century skills and find out innovative ways of doing things and solving unsolved things.

Dr Harish also mentioned that that “**A teacher who listen to students and a student who raise questions are the best.**” He also shared 32 points that teachers must do. He discussed about approaches to make better teaching such as to use videos, remind, reinforce and understand the limitations of the students also. Try to go for one on one interaction before delivering the lecture to understand student. About assessment, Dr Harish suggested that assessments must be for learning not of learner. Dr. Harish concluded that online education is modestly superior to traditional education in terms of student outcomes.

Before the start of session, Dr. S. K. Sinha, Director- BRCM Education Society welcomed guest speaker, Dr. Harish Chaudhry, Shri H.K. Webinar on “ Basic Concept of Research & Applied Statistics” organized by BRCM Education Society

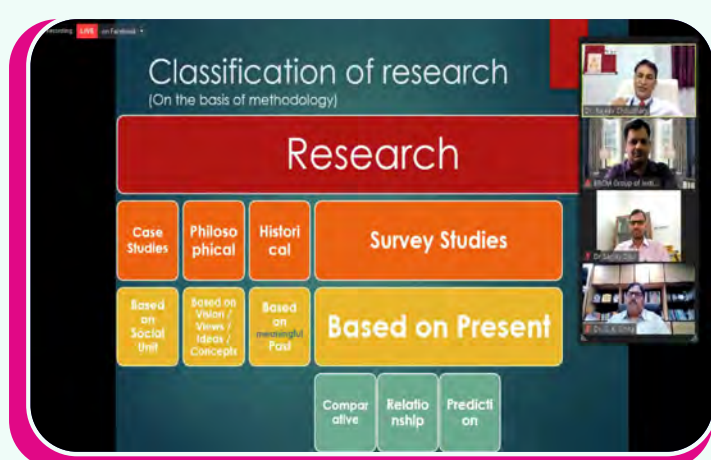

Farewell Party to Dr. S.K.Mishra, Principal

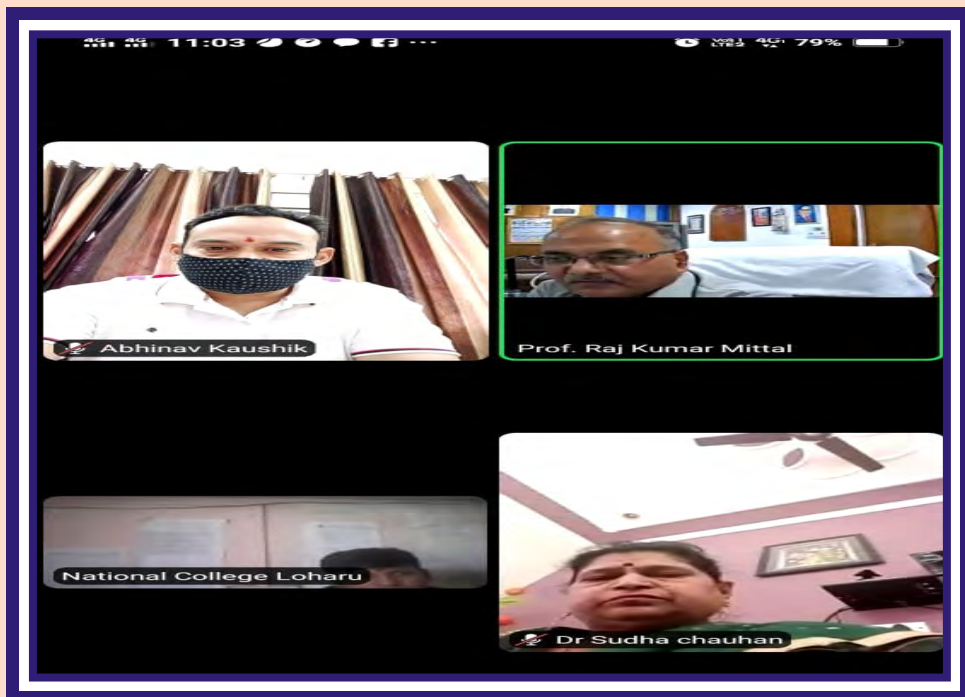

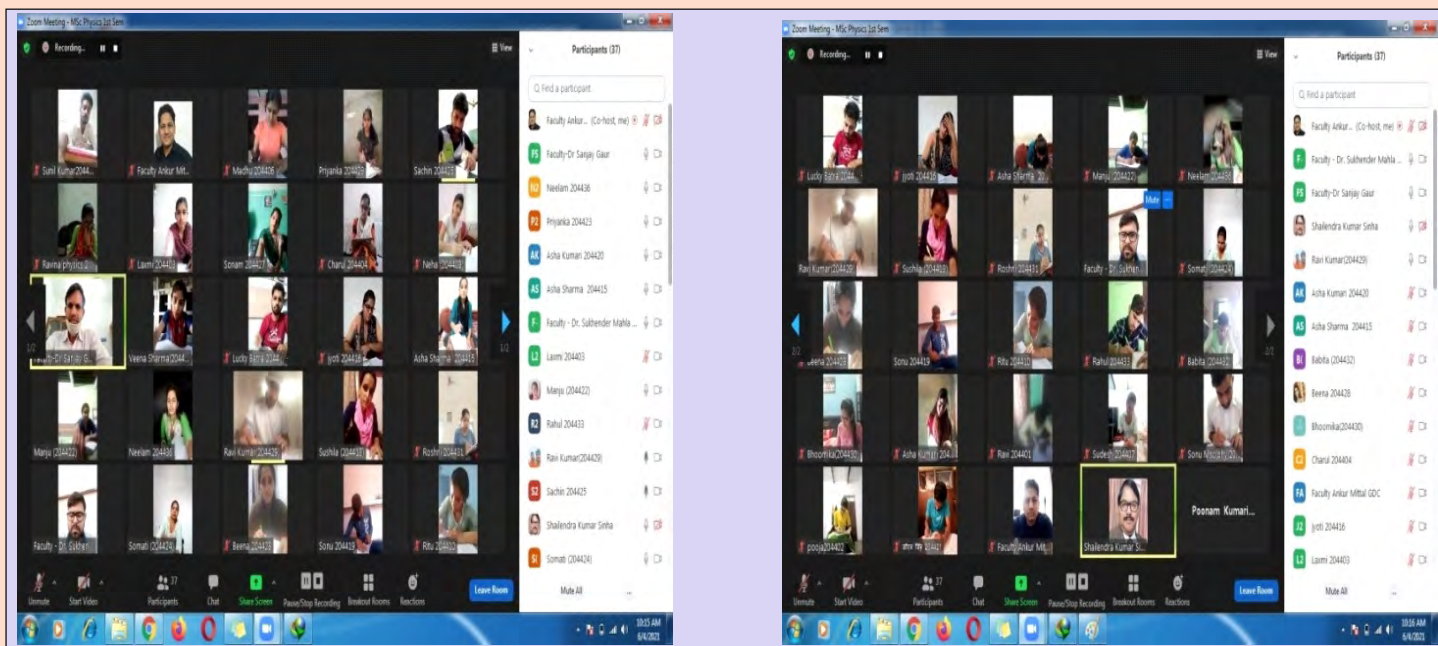

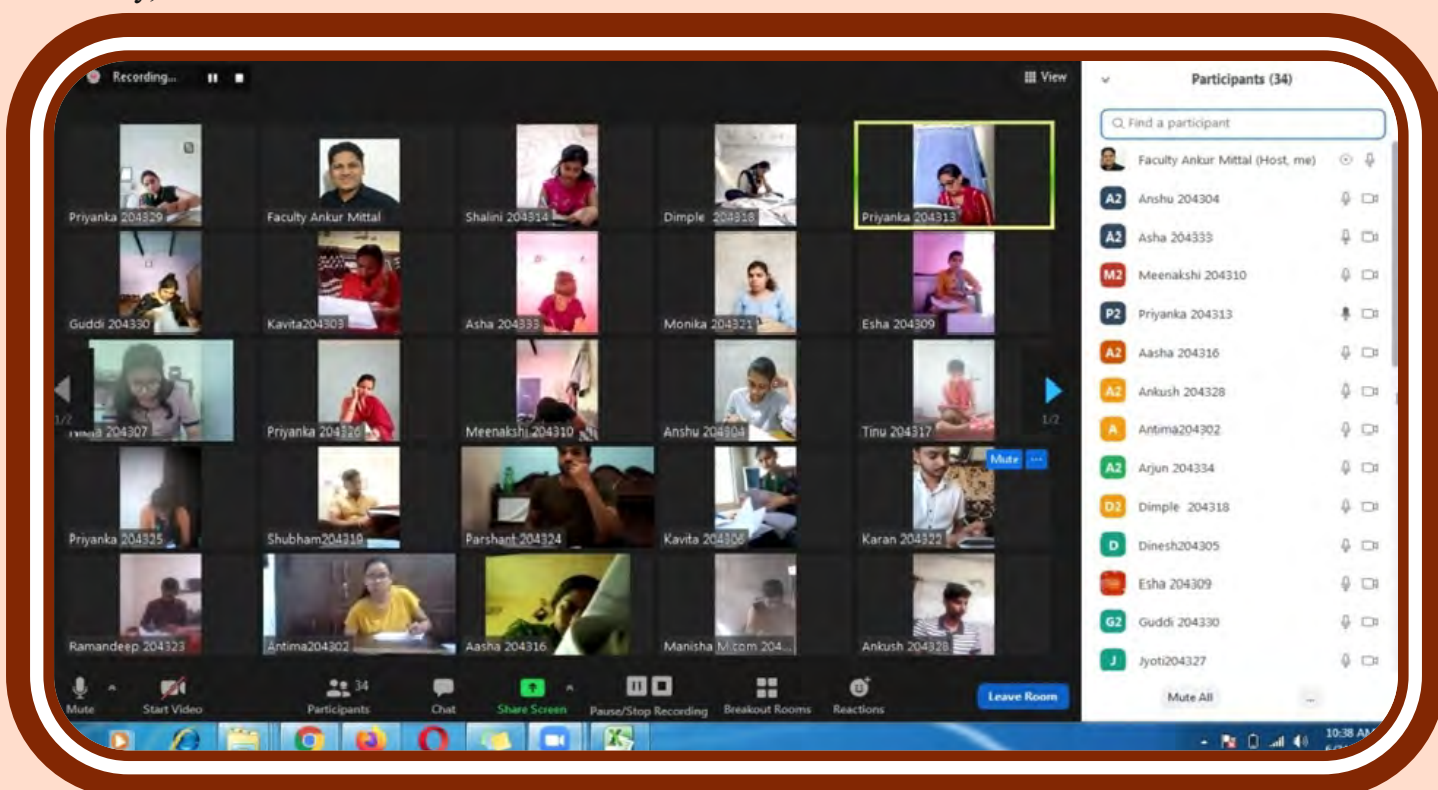
Conduct of Online Examination of PG Courses
