


Hindi Handwriting Competition


Guru Nanak Jayanti

Sanitary Pad Production Unit at SDTC

Common Services Centres (CSC) has more than 35000 women entrepreneurs providing various services to citizens specially in rural India. These CSCs provide digital inclusiveness and support in implementation of various government initiatives as digital literacy, financial inclusion, skill development etc. CSCs has proven self sustainably rural enterprise providing employment to local populace CSCs now venture into a new social initiative “**Stree Swabhiman**” where **Sanitary Napkin Manufacturing Units** are being setup to promote women health and hygiene.

This service provides the employment to 4-5 other women. CSC is empowering its women entrepreneurs to not only provide sanitary pads at their centres but also to educate women of their society to overcome this social taboo and encourage the usage of sanitary pads. It provides unit for manufacturing Bio-degradable, eco-friendly sanitary pads at this units.

- The project focuses on training and establishing a sanitary napkin unit for women and girls to promote menstrual hygiene and to support village level entrepreneurs and SHG groups.
- The intervention proposes to create ongoing livelihood options for 35000 women who will be engaged in the manufacturing process by developing their own entrepreneurial ventures at their CSC Centre.
- The product (sanitary napkin) will be sold under local brand name and marketed by VLEs.
- The project also has a menstrual hygiene related awareness generation component and aims to increase usage of sanitary napkins among rural girls in schools and colleges by making the napkins available at the schools.

The above CSR Activities is funded by Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology, Govt. of India and same has been under taken by BRCM Skill Development Training Center at Bahal, with establishment of a Sanitary Pad Production Unit and four to five workers are being trained for the same. 7000 in numbers of Napkin have been fabricated till date which will be distributed in local Govt. Schools and will further be sold in market.



“Satrangi” a Tailoring Unit at SDTC

Satrangi a tailoring unit at BRCM Skill Development Training Centre with 102 Electric Sewing Machines provided services for the cause of humanity by stitching of PPE Kits for Corona Warriors during Pandemic. During lock down period since from April 2020, the fabrication work of PPE Kits for Corona Warriors were initiated at BRCM Skill Development Training Centre, Bahal and till date approx 52,000 PPE Kits has been fabricated. Presently order for fabrication of Special Type of C & U shaped Pregnancy Pillow has been received and fabrication of the same is under process by following all the necessary precautionary measures and guidelines (SOP) issued by the Govt. of Haryana for the safety, security & protection of the workers.

BRCM ES is managing Manav Kalyan Trust Hospital, a 30-bedded fully functional well equipped modern Hospital for providing affordable tertiary health care facilities for conducting eye checkup, sugar checkup and special general health checkup camps regularly. Presently, the hospital has now added facilities for eye operation (Cataract), Dentistry division along with facilities for Pathology Laboratory for clinical Testing, X-Ray, Eye Testing with modern computerized medical equipment etc. under one roof under the supervision of specialized and trained Medical Doctors and Para Medical Staff. BRCM ES is also planning to add more beds with addition of more specialized medical facilities and Specialized Doctors in near future.
