



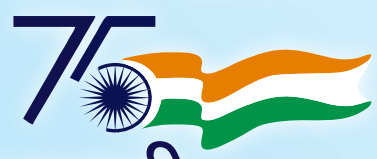

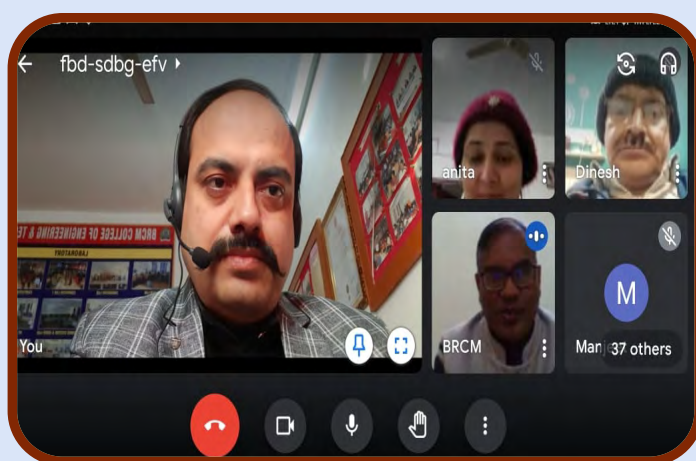

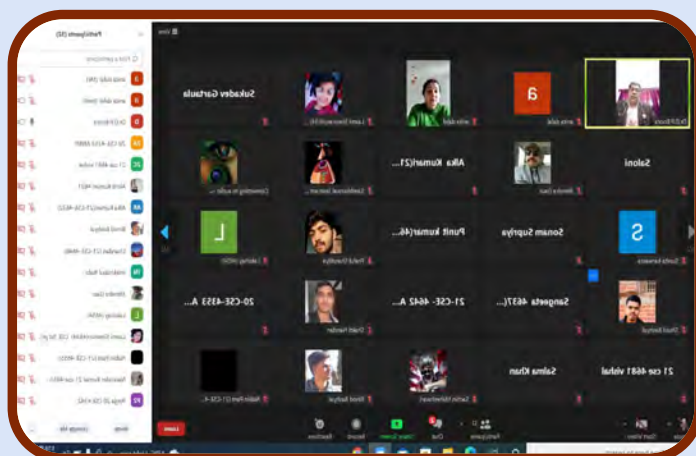
Parents-Teachers Virtual Meeting

Induction Session in IGNOU Centre of College

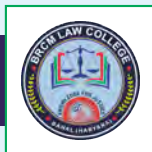

To support FPO farmers, Ballaram Hanumandas Charitable Trust, Bahal organized a two days training programme of Capacity Building for Adoption of Technology (CAT) - Exposure visit on Organic Farming at Morarka Foundation, Nawalgarh (Rajasthan) with financial assistance from NABARD. The two year extension request of BHCT has been accepted by NABARD Chandigarh RO and sanction will be received in July 2022.

About the Hospital

The Trust has taken up the challenging job of renovating and restructuring Manav Kalyan Hospital since 26th January 2006. At present under the aegis of BRCM Education Society "Manav Kalyan Hospital" a charitable health care centre, is doing exemplary work for the service of common man. It provides health care facilities to the people of Bahal and its surrounding villages by specialist doctors including low cost medicines and other advance medical facilities. Its aim is not only to provide treatment at low cost but also to provide surgical facilities for Eye, ENT, Paediatrics, Gynaecological and other general ailments under one roof at the hospital.

Manav Kalyan Hospital is having a fully functional Laboratory with availability of modern Blood testing machine such as CBC Autoanalyzer, Microscope and all types of blood investigation are being carried out in the hospital Laboratory such as CBC, Blood Sugar (F, PP & Random), Liver Function Test, Lipid Profile, RFT, RA factor, Urine RE/ME etc.

Eye operation camp is being organized on every Saturday/Sunday in which 40 to 45 patients are being successfully operated for Cataract every month. Apart from Eye Camp, on 10th of every month Diabetic Camp is also being organized at Manav Kalyan Hospital. The MKH is also running Dental Department with all modern facilities for dental X-ray and surgery. Besides this, many patients suffering from Gynaecological, Cardiac, Diabetes, Cancer, ENT and other ailments get benefit from specialized Medical camps which are organized by the Manav Kalyan Hospital, Bahal from time to time. The Manav Kalyan Hospital has the work load of approx. 15000 out-patients annually and 5000 in-patients annually. The Hospital Management also provides free medicine to the underprivileged & Senior Citizens and organises Blood donation Camp in the Manav Kalyan Hospital from time to time as a noble cause for its dependents populations in and around Bahal. Beside these the students, staff & their families members of various Institutions managed by BRCM ES also gets medical support from the hospital in term of regular medical check up and other emergency medical services.
