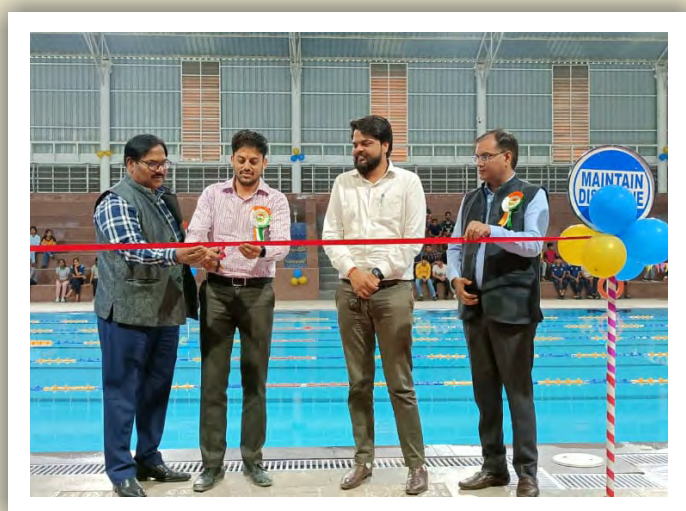
Holika Dahan and Dulhandi Celebration



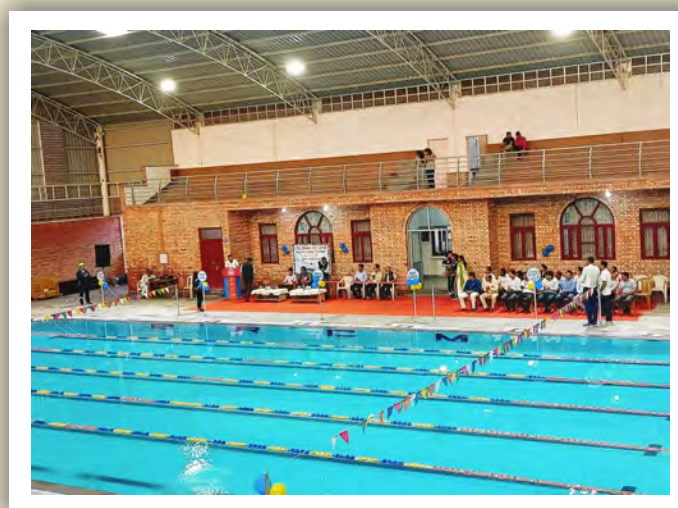

Inauguration of Swimming Summer Camp

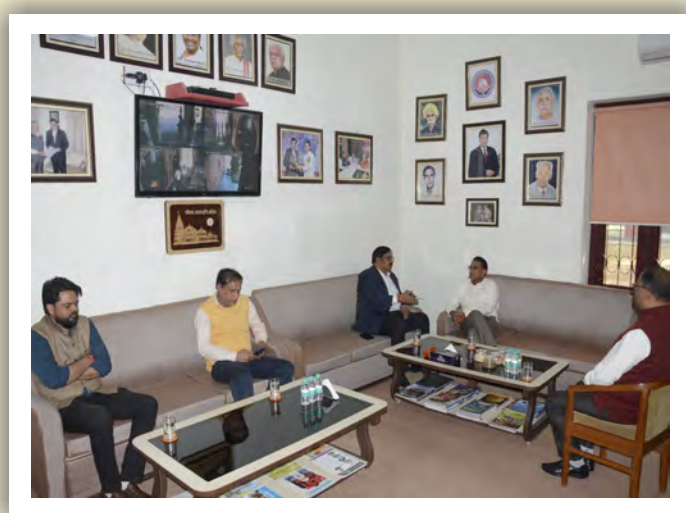

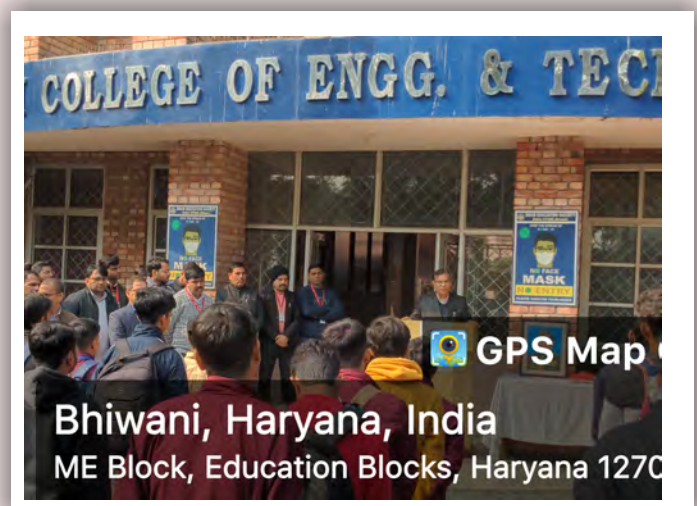
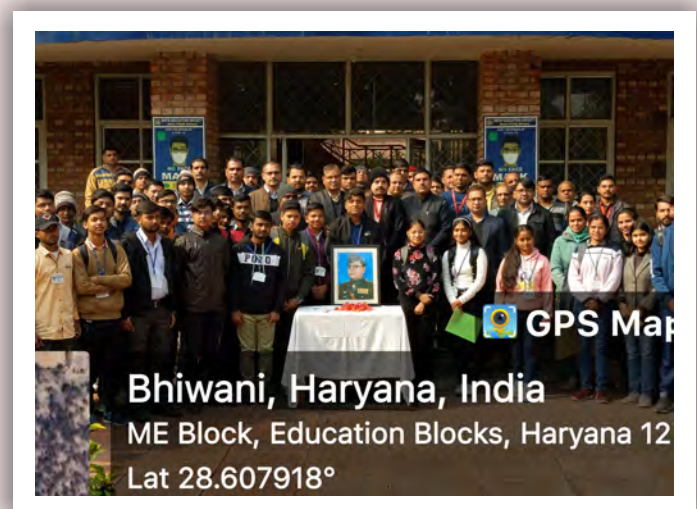
Training and Placement Activities

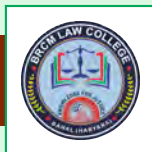
Parakram Diwas

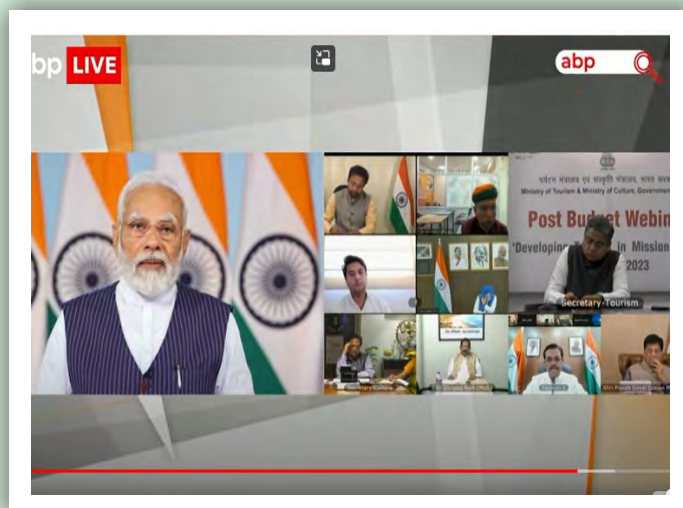
National Lok Adalat

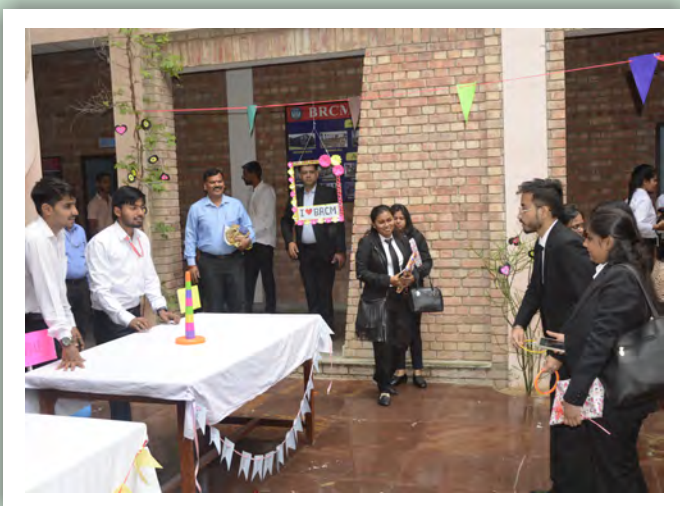
Inspection by CBLU, Bhiwani

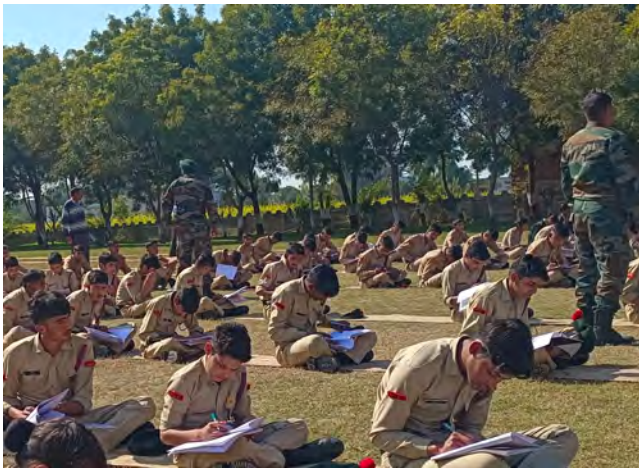
