## *PG Courses Inspection by CBLU Team*

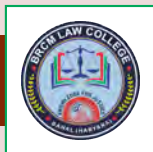

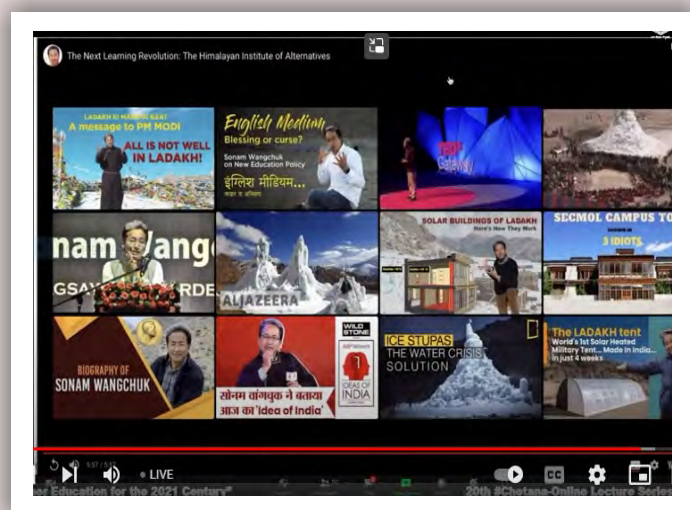
## *Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar Jayanti*

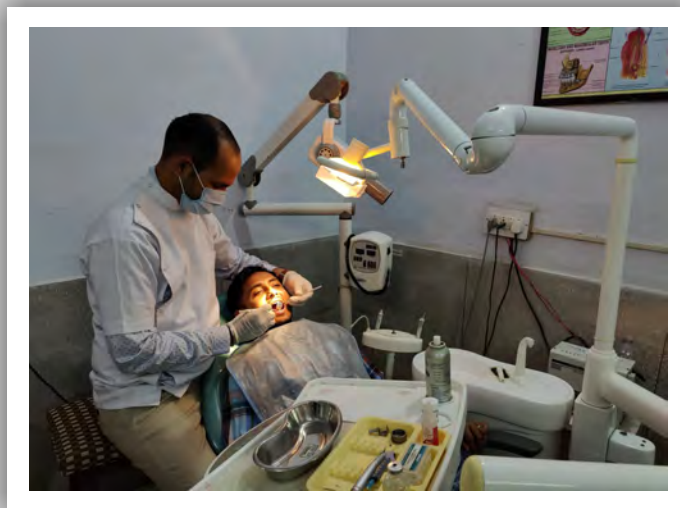
## Manav Kalyan Hospital, Bahal
