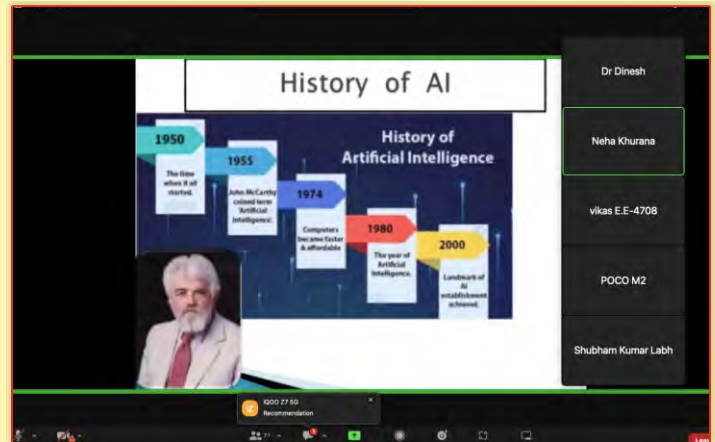
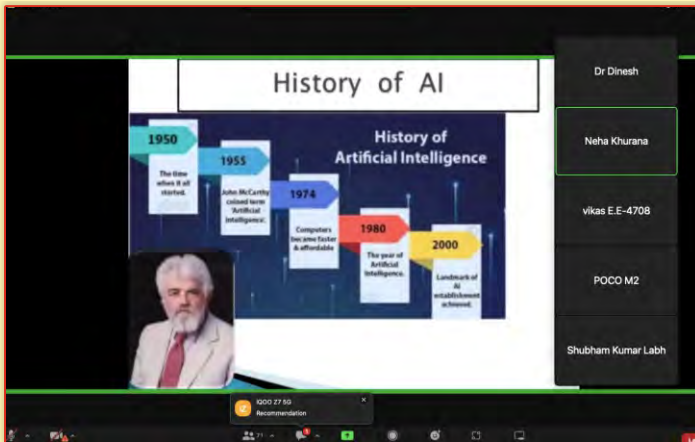

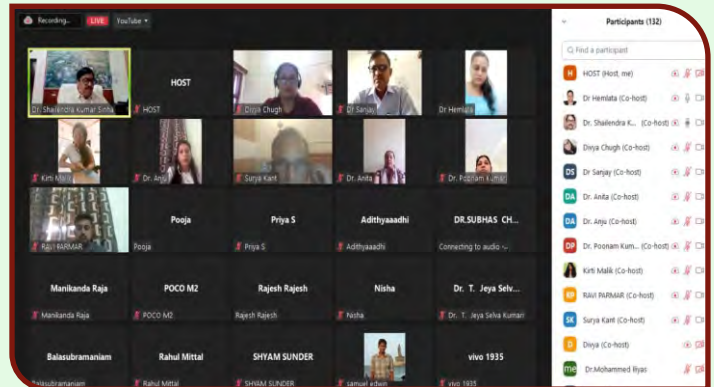
Speech Competition “Women: Economic Independence”

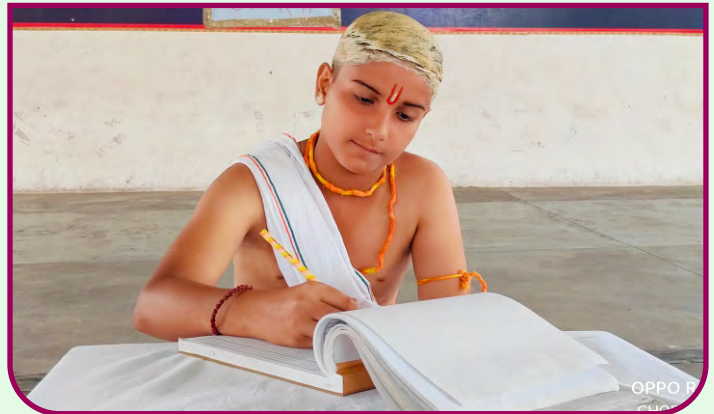
Solo Dance Competition

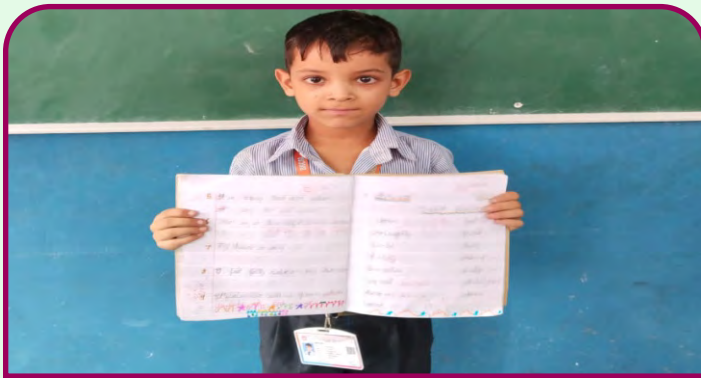
Sports Activities

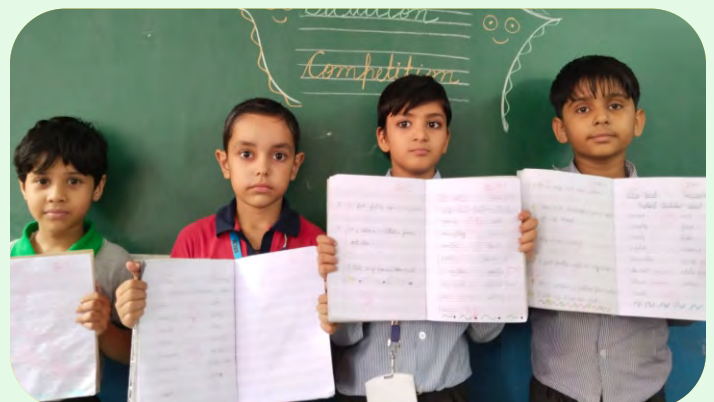
Cub - Bulbul Training Camp
