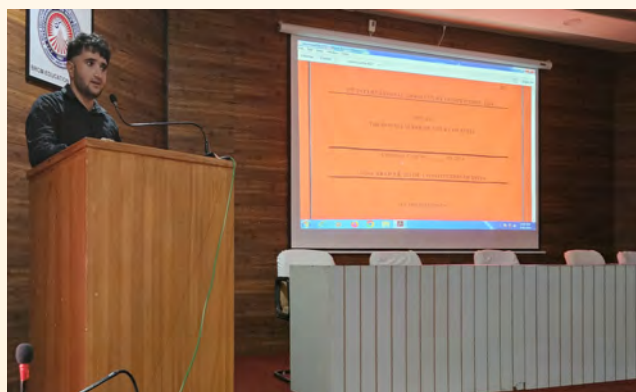
Induction Program

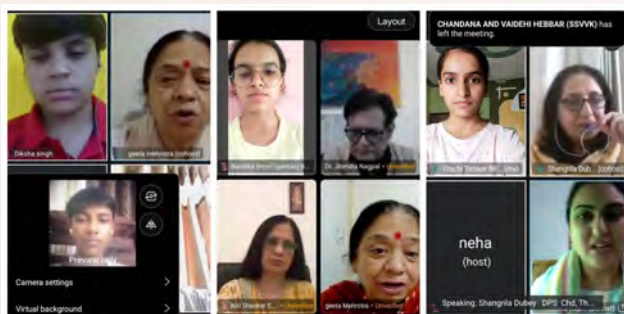
Swimming Competition in Bhiwani

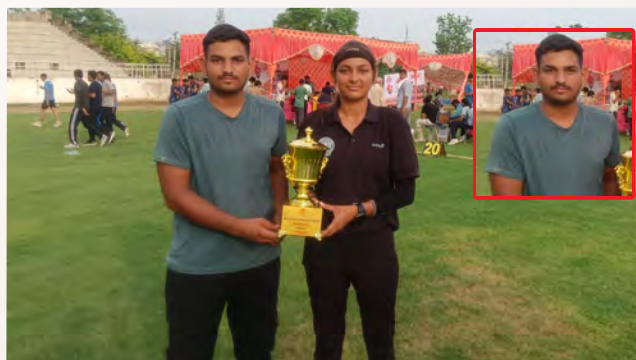


Inter School English Debate Competition

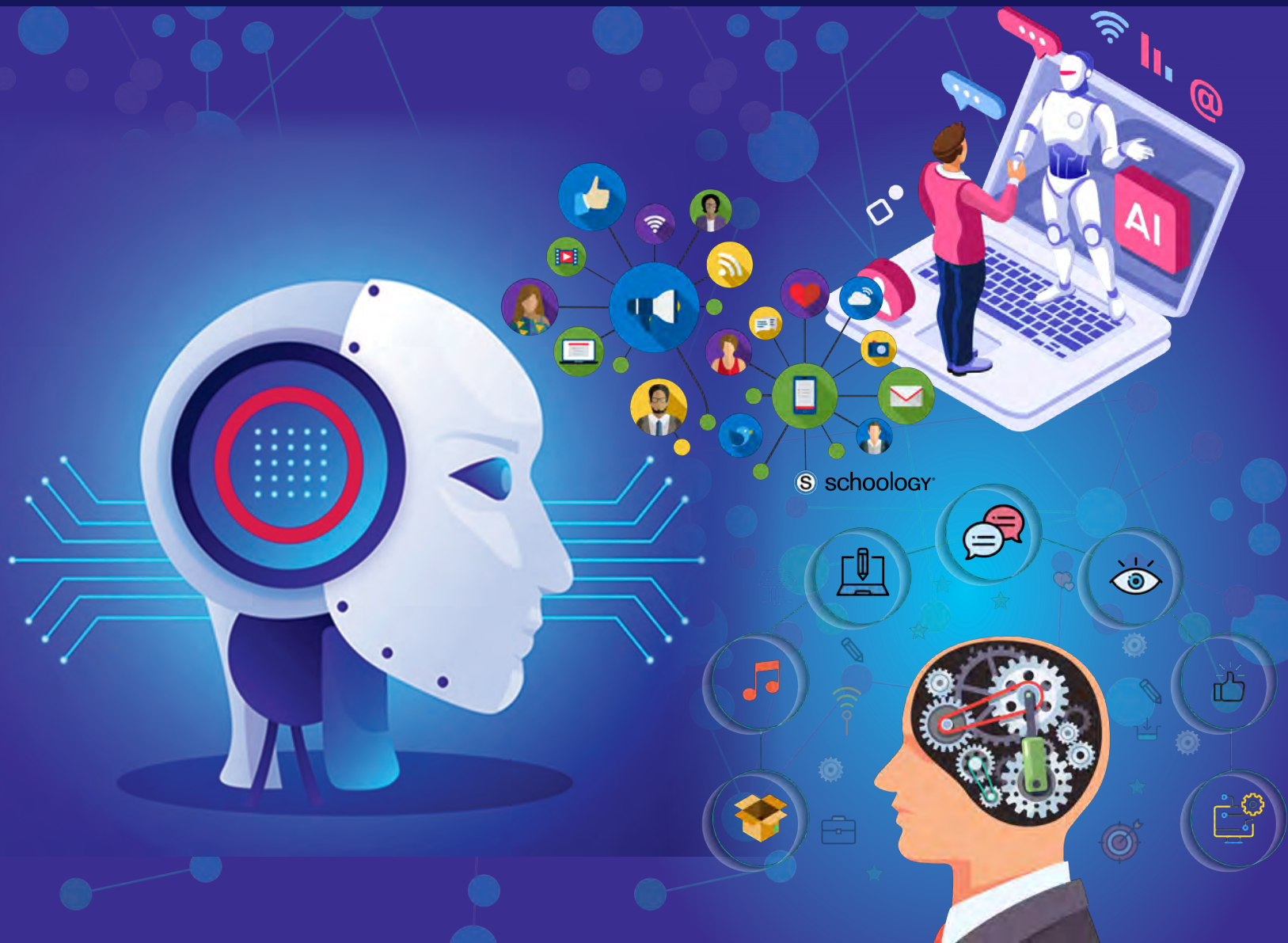
37th Annual Day
