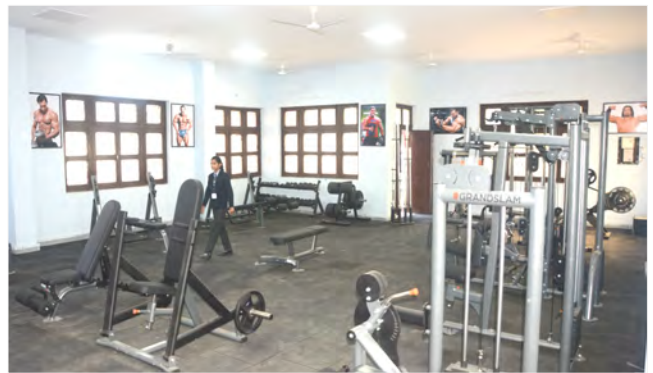
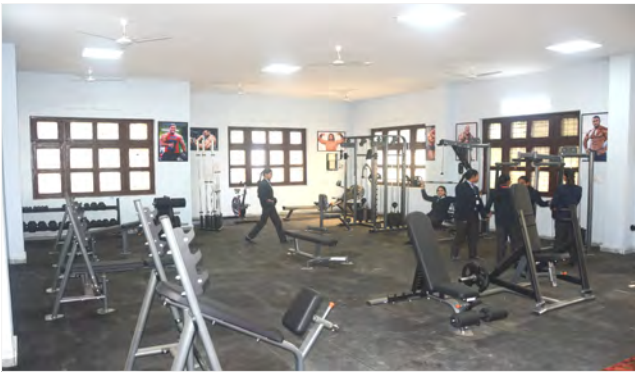

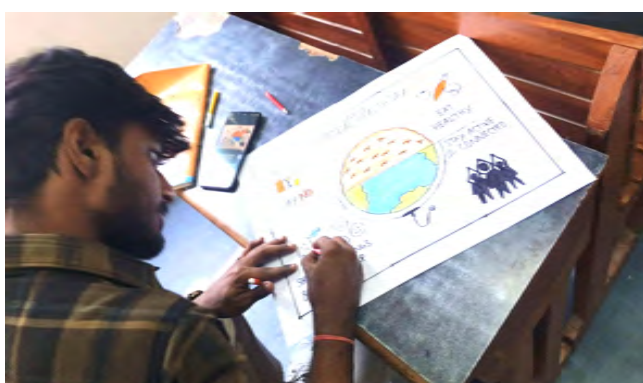
Guest Lecture on "Environmental Acts"

The Department of Botany organized an insightful guest lecture on Environmental Acts on 14th November 2024. The event featured Dr. Anita Dalal, Assistant Professor of Chemistry and EVS, a distinguished expert in environmental law and policy, as the guest speaker. The lecture began with a warm welcome extended to Dr. Anita Dalal by the Head of the Department Dr Poonam. Dr. Dalal commenced her session by emphasizing the critical role of environmental legislation in protecting ecosystems and ensuring sustainable development. She elaborated on key environmental acts, including the Environment Protection Act (1986), the Wildlife Protection Act (1972), the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act (1974), and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act (1981). Dr. Dalal skillfully highlighted the significance of these acts in addressing environmental challenges such as deforestation, pollution, biodiversity loss, and climate change. She shared practical examples to illustrate the implementation and enforcement of these laws in India. Her analysis of landmark cases and legal precedents added depth to the discussion, making it highly engaging for the audience.
